Chromebook Project Update

This summer King's Academy started a Chromebook Campaign. The goal is to put a Chromebook in the hands of all of our 1st-8th grade scholars. That is approximately twenty Chromebooks per classroom. Providing Chromebooks will allow our teachers to establish an individualized learning environment that will address achievement gaps in each classroom. By utilizing Chromebooks, each of our scholars will engage in self-paced learning. With this tool, we can encourage our advanced scholars to continue to excel, our grade level scholars to work toward reaching that superior status; and finally, allow our below grade level scholars to reach grade level status. To date we have raised \$26,000 and purchased two storage/charging carts, software and licenses for sixty-two Chromebooks.
